A motion was m/s/p to spend \$300 on radio advertising for the both Kindergarten Roundup and the School Musical, with the teachers deciding how to divide up the advertising between them.

Carrie Wyatt mentioned that she'd like to set up a dress rehearsal, during the day sometime, for grandparents and other area schools to watch the children perform their School Musical.

We decided that we will definately do the Nicollet Friendship Days Parade on June 27.

Dan will order approximately 30 softball/soccer shirts.

The 7th and 8th grade classroom will organize the School Carnival again this year.

Mrs. Erdman will have an ILS booth set up at the ECFE show in New Ulm on April 10.

We discussed adding to the basketball work schedule next year, a slot for cleaning bleachers after home basketball games.

We discussed the possibility of setting up a lounge area with a sink, microwave and fridge in the principal's office. Lisa Fischer mentioned that they have cupboards to donate to the school, if we'd like to use them.
