Lisa Fischer has taken care of registering us for the Nicollet Friendship Days parader. We'll talk more about the parade and the parade committee at our May meeting. Missy Bode will check into what the cost to participate in the New Ulm parade is.

Mr. Erdman is working on finalizing the softball schedule. There are quite a few 7th and 8th graders playing softball and baseball with Nicollet Public this spring.

We've ordered an additional 10 Shooter Shirts for those that didn't order one this year, to use next year. We also presented Ruth Klossner a Braves sweatshirt, which she appreciated.

Athletic fees of \$10 per sport are due. There is no fee for playing softball or cheerleading.

We talked about plans to get brochures to area Chambers; 1 or 2 brochures into each member's box at church; we'll hand them out at the Friendship Days parade; and possibly have a booth at the Nicollet County and/or Brown County Fairs. We'll talk more about it at the May meeting.

We talked about advertising on The Wall, maybe running an ad a couple of months in the summer (July/August). Sue Erdman will get information on cost.
