Grades 5-8 will attend a Civil War reenactment at Martin Luther High School on January 27.

Good Shepherd Lutheran School in North Mankato has invited our entire school to participate in a Jesus Food event on January 30. A MOTION was made and seconded for the PTL to sponsor a bus for our students to attend this event. Discussion followed. The motion PASSED.

Our Lutheran Schools Week service project will be Project Linus, no-sew blankets for a homeless shelter. A MOTION was made and seconded for the PTL to donate \$250 for project supplies. Discussion followed. The motion PASSED.

Young Writers and Artists Conference. Students in grades 3-8 will attend this event on March 11. The total cost is \$15/student. A MOTION was made and seconded for PTL to pay \$10/student and for families to pay \$5/student. Discussion followed. The motion PASSED.

Valentine's Day Party. Michelle Schroeder will donate milk for the Valentine's Day party. A MOTION was made and seconded to let the teachers decide what kind of cookies to buy the kids, turn in the bill and PTL will pay. Discussion followed. The motion PASSED.

Water Fountain. Lisa Stein reported that a water bottle filler attachment is available for our water fountain. A MOTION was made and seconded to pay up to \$600 for the purchase this attachment. Discussion followed. The motion PASSED.

Backdrops. We need to purchase backdrops for use at our Christmas programs and other events. Jodi Goff and Missy _____ will investigate options and report back to the PTL in March.
