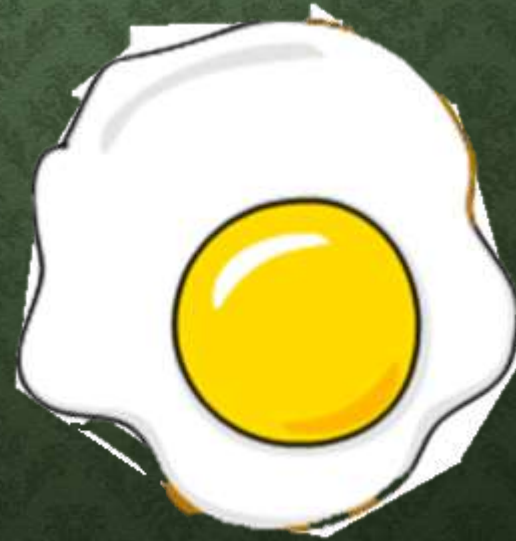


ORGANIZATION OF CELLS

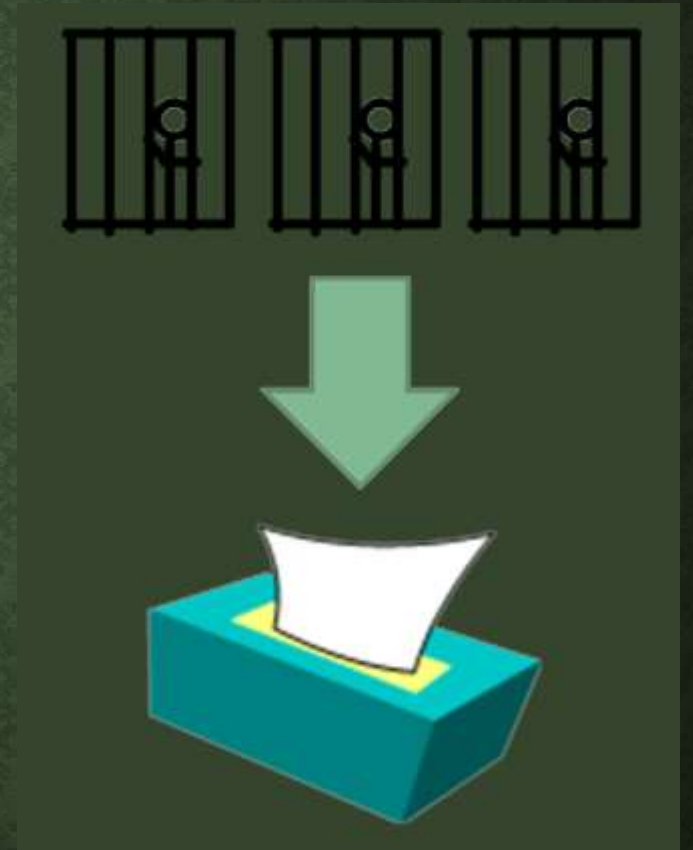
CELLS

- Very small

- What's the largest cell?



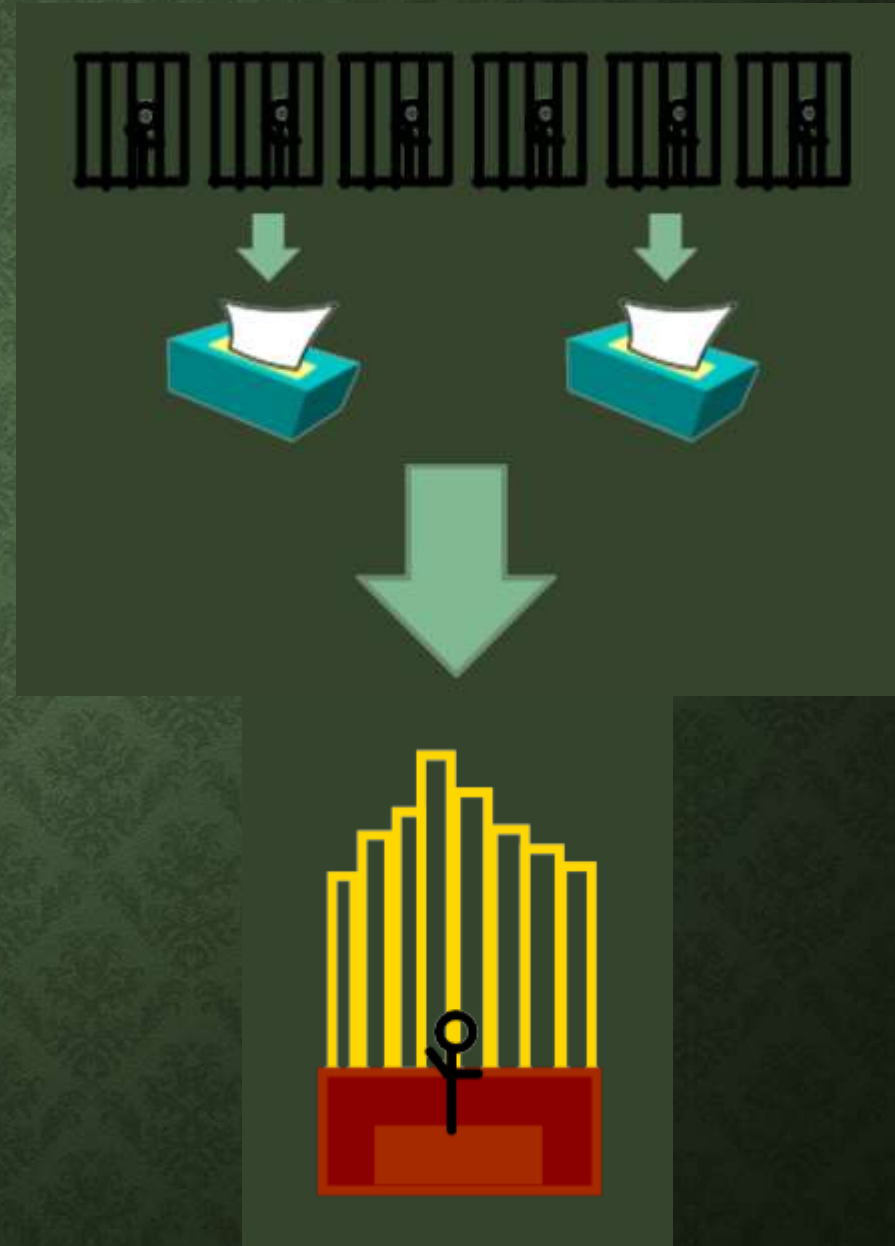
TISSUES

- **What kinds of tissues does your body have?**



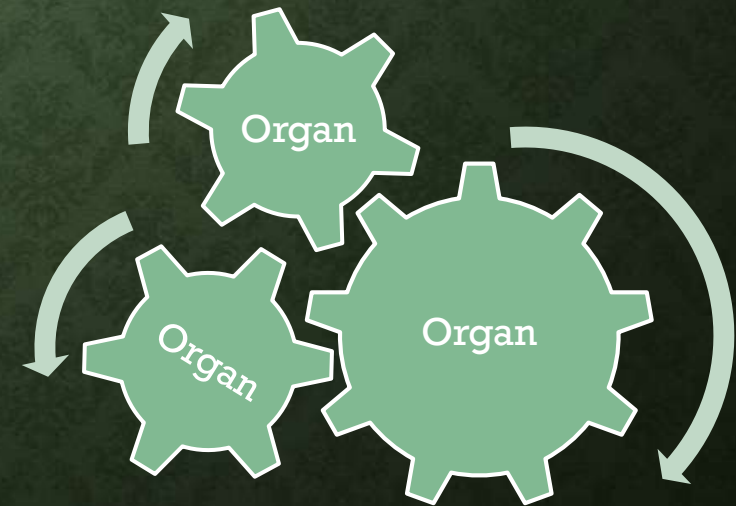
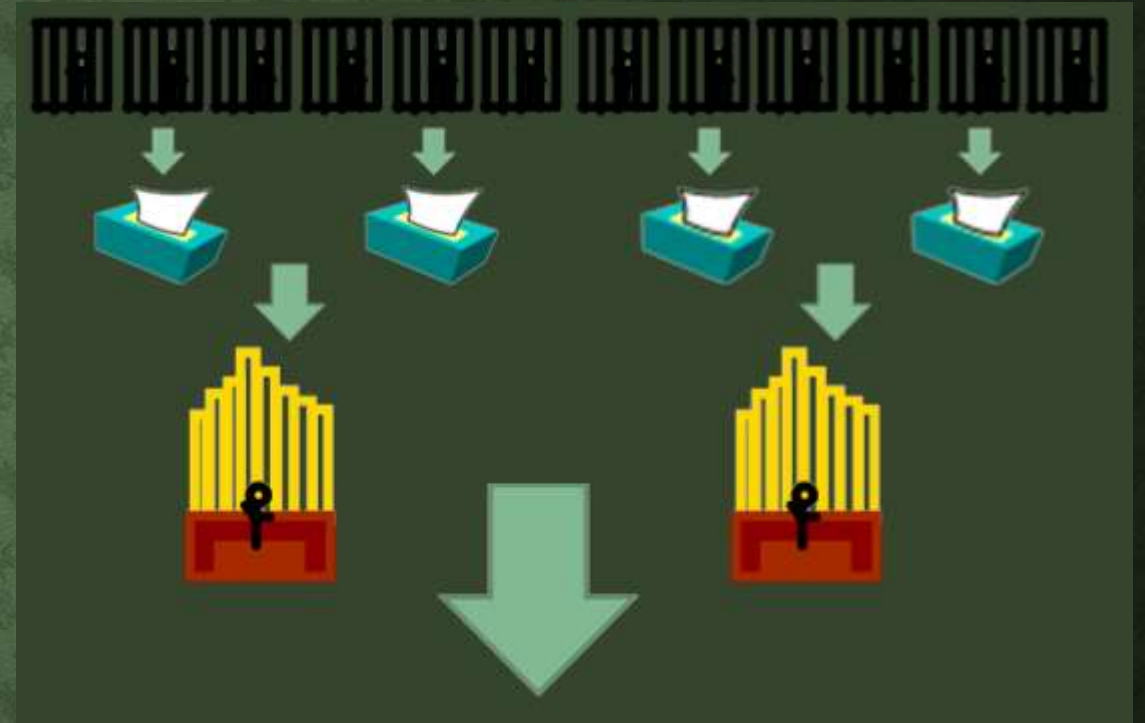
ORGANS

- Two or more tissues working together to do a job
- What organs can you think of?



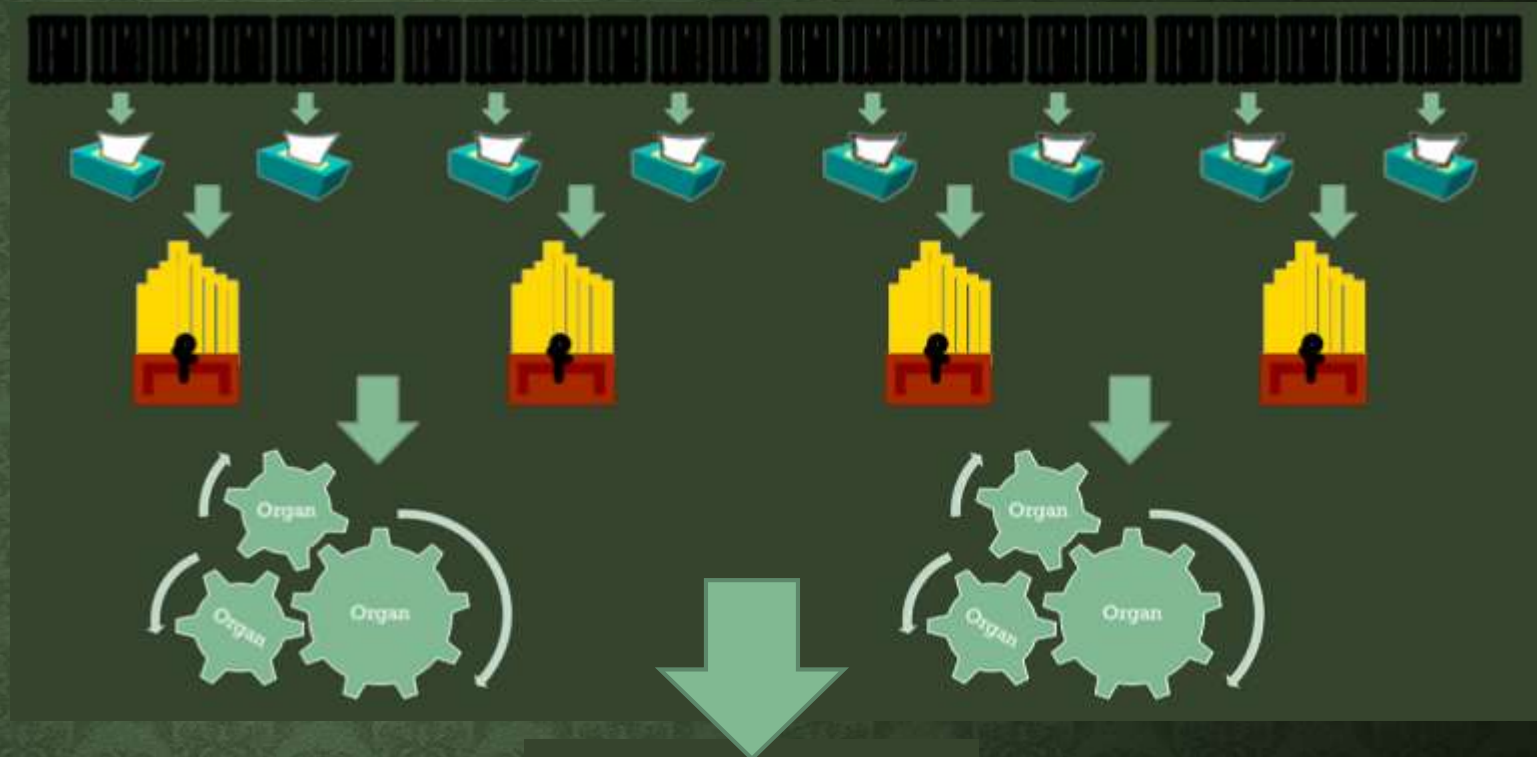
ORGAN SYSTEMS

- Organs working together to do a job
- Depend on each other
- **Which organ systems can you name?**
- **How do they work together?**



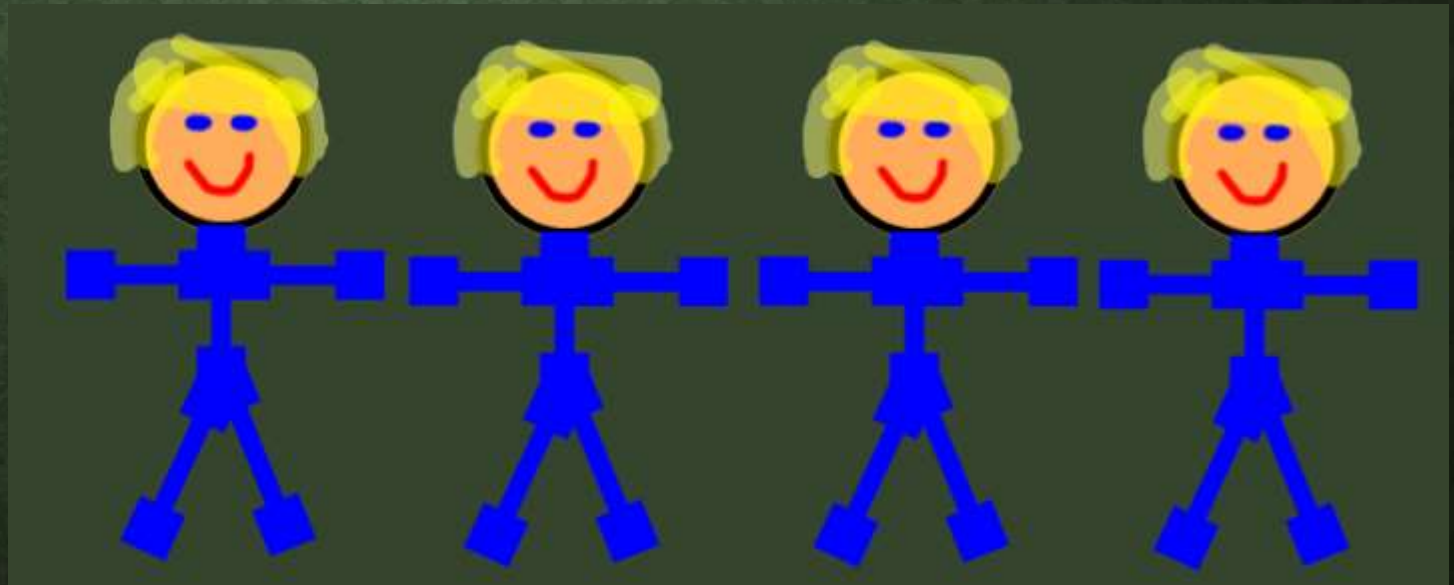
ORGANISMS

- Anything that can live on its own
- Made of at least one cell
 - **Unicellular**= one cell
 - **Multicellular**= many cells



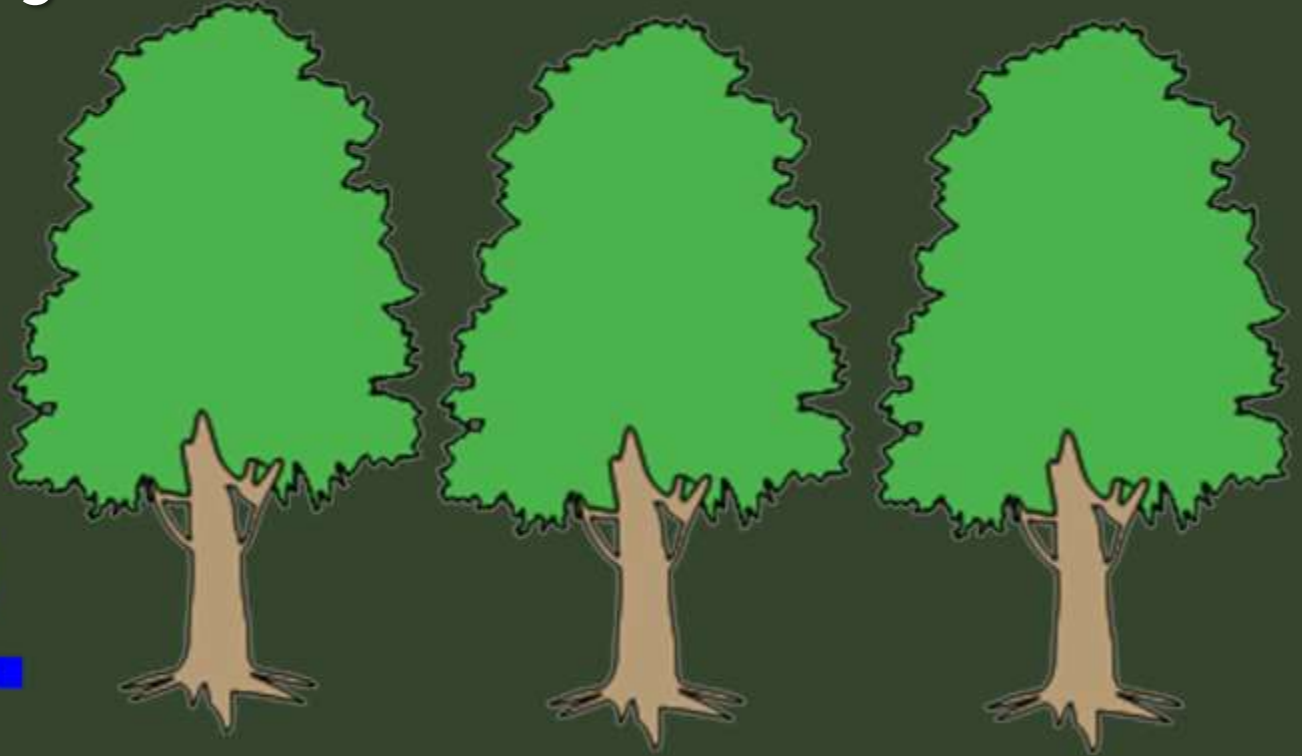
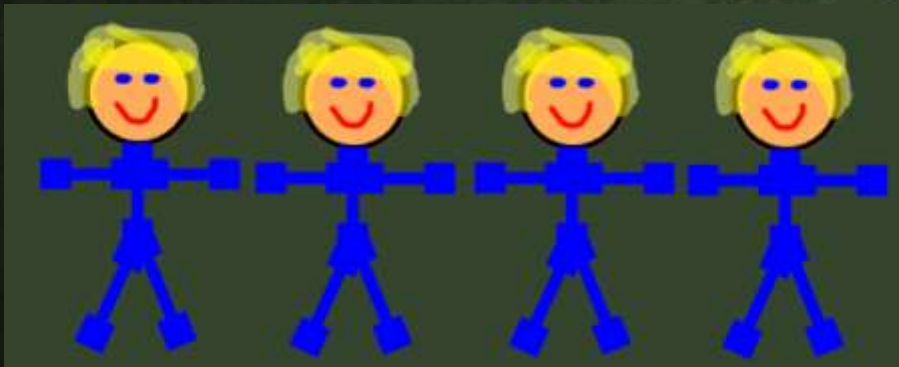
POPULATIONS

- Groups of organisms living in the same area
- Same kind of organisms



COMMUNITIES

- Two or more populations living in the same area
- Must be living!

- A community and all the nonliving things that effect it
