Mammary glands

- Females= secrete milk
- Males= inactive (but still there)
- Have hair
- Endotherms
- Four limbs
- Give birth to live young
- Specialized teeth (made for specific tasks)
- Diaphragm- a muscle that pulls air into the lungs
